

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
### DECEMBER ACTIVITIES

They created their own monster by using a variety of lines with crayons. Students painted over their lines with their color choice of watercolors. Each of the students finished their monster by collaging on eyes, noses, mouth, ears, and other accessories to their monsters. Morgan and Brooklyn both thought cutting out the mouth for their monster was the most challenging. They both enjoyed painting their monster, and they learned all about different types of lines.

Chase Dawe and Mackenzie Van Der Walt, are the featured artists of the week with their geode artworks. Students learned about geodes and how they are formed within the earth. Students were challenged to create their own geodes using watercolors and learning to blend the colors together. Students drew organic shapes to be seen as rocks around the geodes, while adding patterns within the "rocks" with a Sharpie. Students painted gold around the edge of the geodes to resemble the glittering crystals that grow in geodes. Chase learned that geodes can all be different colors. Mackenzie said the most challenging part was drawing the patterns in the geodes. Chase and Mackenzie both really enjoyed watercoloring the geodes.
