absorb: to soak up or take in

The solar panels on the roof of our house absorb energy from the sun.

avoid: to stay away from someone or something

Our neighbor's dog does not like strangers so it is best to avoid him.

commit: to say that you will definitely do something

School volunteers commit to helping students when they are available.

coordinate: to organize something that involves a lot of people

Our government teacher will coordinate a field trip to Washington, D.C.

decorate: to make something look nice

Colorful, fresh flowers were used to <u>decorate</u> tables for the party.

distribute: to give something to each person in a group

Before beginning the game, you must distribute seven cards to each player.

fluctuate: to change unevenly

The number of people visiting the zoo can <u>fluctuate</u> daily.

gather: to bring together in a group

Josh will use a rake to gather the leaves in his front yard.

obtain: to get something

The speaker began his presentation with a joke to <u>obtain</u> his audience's attention.

permit: to allow someone to do something

The city park does not <u>permit</u> overnight camping.

pursue: to work hard in order to achieve something

Jessica's drama coach encouraged her to pursue an acting career.

reduce: to make something smaller in number or size

Bad weather could <u>reduce</u> the number of people attending the outdoor concert.
