dense: thick; crowded; difficult to see or move through

The panda bears living in the <u>dense</u> bamboo forests of China are slowly becoming extinct.

evident: clear and easy to see

The accident caused evident damage to our car; it will need to be repaired.

flexible: able to bend or change easily

Simon's basketball shoes are made from leather and have very flexible soles.

gradual: happening slowly over a long period of time

Changes to our environment are <u>gradual</u> and not always obvious.

isolated: far away from other things

After six months in space, the astronauts felt <u>isolated</u> and wanted to return home.

prominent: somewhere or something that is easily seen

If you put your car keys in a prominent place, they will be easy to find.

rigid: not easy to bend or move

The new bridge is made of rigid steel beams that will support a lot of weight.

sacred: extremely important or greatly respected

Maria's Latin American family celebrates many sacred traditions.
