bias:

complement:

something that completes something and makes it whole or perfects it

consensus:

an agreement amongst a group of people

heredity:

the process by which features and characteristics are passed on from parents to children

judicious:

having, using, or showing good judgment; wise; sensible

misconception:

an idea that is not correct or which has been misunderstood

random:

by chance; lacking a clear plan, purpose, or pattern

reminisce:

to think and talk about the past

resemblance:

a similarity in appearance between people and/or things

subtle:

not immediately obvious or noticeable
