## complex: having a lot of different parts; difficult to understand

The architect's designs for the new shopping area are very complex.

#### critical: very important or serious

Calvin's brother required a critical heart operation shortly after he was born.

# dependent: needing someone or something in order to live or continue

Our plan to go sailing will be <u>dependent</u> upon calm water and light winds.

### exhausted: very tired or worn out; used up completely

The swimmers were <u>exhausted</u> after completing their relay.

### intense: very great or strong

Very few animals can survive the *intense* heat of the Sahara desert.

### mutual: shared by two or more people

Abigail and Patrick have a <u>mutual</u> appreciation for science fiction novels.

#### obvious: easy to notice or understand

Midway through the wrestling tournament, it was <u>obvious</u> which team would win.

### outstanding: extremely good

The actor's performance in the movie was <u>outstanding</u>; he may win an award.

# practical: appropriate for a particular purpose and able to be used

It is <u>practical</u> to carry an umbrella on a cloudy day.

### precise: exact and correct

Matt gave his friends precise directions to the bowling alley.
