DISTRICT 100 BOARD OF EDUCATION  
REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 8, 2021 - 7:00 P.M.**

Motion by Burnham, second by Smith to approve the agenda as presented. Carried 6-0. Voting aye: Ballagh, Burnham, Dobbins, Plock, Smith and Snyder. Voting nay: none. Absent and not voting: none.

Motion by Smith, second by Ballagh to approve the minutes of the February 15, 2021 regular meeting as corrected. Carried 5-0-1. Voting aye: Ballagh, Burnham, Plock, Smith and Snyder. Voting nay: none. Abstaining, Dobbins. Absent and not voting: none.
