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Policy compliance results

Noted strengths in wellness policy are the local fresh grown greens and beef for the cafeteria. Our K-12 PE curriculum is strong and vibrant with new equipment and objectives annually. Local GLW Council has members provide current topic discussion and education for healthy choices even if tough topics for K-6.

Partially completed nutrition education goal will be fine tuned to choose 1 week and a selected topic for consistency and classroom, PE class and lunch room consistent involvement.

Opportunities for improvements:

1. Consider automatic water container filling stations.
2. Hold a family centered activity to foster family physical activity.
3. Verify compliance with USDA Smart Snacks requirements during school hours

Wellness policy goals

1. Nutrition education/promotion goal to have all students learn 1 nutrition concept either in the classroom or cafeteria.
2. Physical activity at least 30 minutes a day for all students K-12 via PE or recess/break time.
3. Goal of student grown items from our own BPS greenhouse on the salad bar at least twice a month.

These goals are for the most part being achieved by educators selecting health/wellness topics for classroom level as fits throughout the year. Physical activity whether sports,

pre-school start weightlifting, PE class and recess/break time opportunities are many and beyond the 30 minute goal. The greenhouse is still in its first few years of use. So fun to see the differing ideas come through the students for not only the school cafeteria but the science fair, class experiments, etc.

Key achievements

1. The greenhouse use and evolution for produce, flowers, wintering annual plants through winter and more is just beginning.
2. PE curriculum enhancement in the last year with good student satisfaction modeled from staff being more active.
3. Mental health, a continual piece for staff to be educated and in constant surveillance of students and other staff. A perpetual cycle that needs awareness and reback by all staff for the safest environment and earliest interventions.

Next Steps

The wellness group has discussed taking a student and staff poll of what 3 major current topics they would like to see curriculum, school assembly about, activities focus, cafeteria item ideas, greenhouse new ideas for usage, etc.

Also, choosing a theme/topic of nutrition to educate on K-12. A week will be selected and teachers will be communicated with. Mr. Gideon will follow up with and also do random activities in PE to coincide with this. Jr/Sr High will have a poster board by salad bar with themed information and Mr Gideon will pop into the lunchroom during identified week and do some trivia style nutritional learning.
