

Permission to Drive Home During the Lunch Period

The Burwell Jr. Sr. High School offers its students the opportunity to leave school during the student's scheduled lunch period as long as they are not late in returning to school and do it in a safe and law abiding manner. Students are also allowed the privilege of driving their vehicles home for lunch. This waiver must be signed and returned to the Principal's office. **This waiver is giving your son or daughter permission to drive themselves or household members only during lunch.** The following rules must be followed if a student drives during their lunch period:

1. Safety is a must while driving. If a student drives recklessly then the student will lose the privilege of driving during their lunch period.
2. The student must return to their scheduled class on time.
3. Students must follow the laws established by the state of Nebraska (i.e speed limit, valid license, properly registered vehicle, ect)
4. Students are not allowed to just drive around during their lunch period. Multiple students driving around two together is not allowed.

This is a privilege and should not be taken for granted. If a student does not follow these rules then they will lose their driving privileges during their lunch period. Student safety is the primary concern.

This form will need to be signed and returned to the Principal's office before students can drive during lunch.
